The lacerations on her head were consistent with having fallen on a sharp edge of coping that protruded into the spa. A neighbor peaking through her fence misinterpreted what she saw, began embellishing what she had observed every time she repeated the story, and convinced the police that she saw Mr. Hall struggle with his wife in the spa, and hold his wife's head under water until she drowned.
