Boating Tip #55: Sailing Participation Agreement

Participation agreements are not waivers, but are assumption of risk documents that might be helpful if litigation ensues after an activity related incident. Having participants sign participation agreements prior to taking part in a sailing activity may reduce your exposure to loss. You may be able to show that the participant had a knowledge and understanding of the risks, and an appreciation for the risks involved in participation.

Participation agreements explain the nature of the activity, expected participant behavior, the risks involved in the activity, the condition of the participant, include a concluding statement, and require that the participant acknowledge and sign the document.

In the nature of the activity, the activity is described in detail. Specific skills required for safe participation are listed. The intensity of the activity and physical stress involved is explained.

When describing the expected participant behavior, list important or unusual rules which contribute to safe participation.

When explaining the risks involved in the activity list types of accident which might occur, including minor, major, and catastrophic life-threatening injuries that might result. List common accidents and injuries, but don't try to be all inclusive. Use phrases such as "...including but not limited to".

List the pre-requisite participant physical condition and any pre-requisite skill competencies the participant must possess. Require that participants disclose conditions which might prevent or be relevant to safe participation.

Prior to signing and dating the agreement, Conclude with a statement that the participant affirms knowledge, understanding and appreciation of the risks of participation, and that participation is voluntary.

Read and explain the agreement to participants. Allow time for discussion and for questions and answers. Require that participants sign and return the agreement to you, and keep the agreement for at least 3 years.

Risks Involved in the Activity

We do not want to heighten your fears or reduce your enthusiasm for the experience, but we do want you to know in advance what to expect and to be informed of the

various risks. This is not a complete list of the risks you may encounter. It is your responsibility to get additional information about the risks you are about to undertake.

- I acknowledge that ocean sailing entails known and unanticipated risks which could result in minor or catastrophic physical or emotional injury, paralysis, death, damage to personal property, or injury to third parties.
- I understand that such risks cannot be completely eliminated without jeopardizing the essential nature and qualities of the activity.
- Risks of participation include, but are not limited to: exposure to adverse weather conditions, being ejected, thrown or washed overboard or falling into the water; injuries from climbing on or off the boat, hypothermia, sunburn, heat exhaustion or heat stroke, seasickness, slip-and-fall, being cut or impaled by sharp objects, bruises, head trauma, sprains, strains, broken bones, dislocations, encounters with dangerous marine life, sinking of the boat, and death by drowning.
- The captain and crew may be ignorant of your fitness level or abilities. They might misjudge the weather or elements. They might give inadequate warnings or instruction. Equipment may break or malfunction.
- I understand that there is a chance of injury resulting from the negligence and carelessness on the part of the captain and crew, and fellow sailors.

Condition of the Participant

- You must be in moderate physical condition, have good balance, be able to move about a sailboat while underway, and be able to climb on and off a boat unassisted.
- You may participate in the activity if you are a novice or inexperienced sailor, but may
 be given instruction and asked to participate in necessary activities to assure your
 safety, the safety of the crew and passengers, and the safety of the vessel.
- You must have intermediate level swimming ability, be able to tread water in the open ocean for a period of not less than 20 minutes, or at all times while topside, wear a USCG approved PFD.

Expected Participant Behavior

- As required by _____ (state) law, all children under ____ years of age, while topside, must wear a properly sized and fastened PFD.
- In inclement weather conditions, at night, or at any time when directed by the Captain to do so, you must don a PFD, harness and tether, or other safety gear.
- I understand that that use of illegal drugs or excessive consumption of alcohol may endanger myself or other participants. I agree not to use any illegal drugs or excessive alcohol while undertaking this activity.
- I understand that this is a non-smoking trip. As such, the consumption of any tobacco product will not be permitted while on-board the vessel.
- While we strive to operate the safest possible vessel, equipment and programs for the enjoyment of our guests, you are primarily responsible for your own safety and the safety of any minor children who accompany you aboard the boat.
- Follow directions of the captain and crew. We will be happy to give you a tour of the vessel, explain safety rules, administer a swim test, or show you how to properly use

- any equipment upon your request. Please ask questions if you do not fully understand the rules established for your safety, or do not fully appreciate the risks involved in participation, or in using any piece of equipment aboard the vessel.
- The safety rules have been developed for your protection. Failure to heed warnings, partaking in unsafe behavior or activities in which you are not qualified, or misuse or abuse of equipment can result in serious or even fatal injury.
